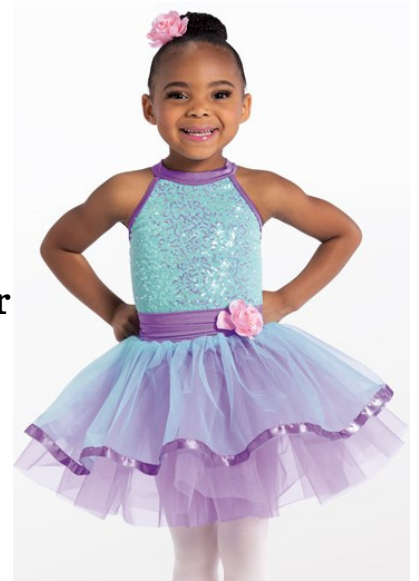

Everything You Need To Know From Head to Toe

Costumes

Each student has received a "made to order" costume. Made to order means they are made when we place the order. Costumes are not made to dancer's exact measurements, companies use general sizing charts. This means some alterations may need to be made to your child's costume. Any alterations will be your responsibility. If you have any questions about your costumes please reference the costume book that was emailed or you can see the one in the studio office. **PLEASE LABEL!** It is very important that you put your child's name on all shoes, costumes and accessories, etc. We cannot guarantee the return of personal items left at the theatre.



Labeling

It is very important that you put your child's name on **ALL** shoes, costumes, accessories, etc. Please **LABEL, LABEL, LABEL!** We cannot guarantee the return of personal items left at the theatre.

Hair, Tights, and Shoes

A tights and shoe list was emailed early this year. The list will be emailed again.

HAIR

Dancers should have all hair pulled away from the face (including bangs) and placed in a low bun at the nape of the neck. Hairnets need to be used along with hairpins (the kind that separate). Bobby pins will fall out easily. Use bobby pins only for holding in hair pieces that are part of a costume.

Hairspray, Hairspray, Hairspray!

TIGHTS

You may only wear Capezio Brand tights unless specified differently by your teacher!

BALLET SHOES

All ballet shoes need to have elastic straps sewn, not tied to the sides of shoes. Please tie strings at the top of the ballet shoe in a double knot and cut off 1/4" from the knot.

TAP SHOES

Tap shoes usually come with ribbons that tie. Please remove the ribbon and replace it with an elastic strap that is tacked (sewn) together.

JAZZ SHOES

All jazz shoes need to be Bloch Elasta Bootie. Please see the list for color.

ACRO SHOES

Acro shoes only come in white and will need to be painted.

Color: Sand

HIPHOP SHOES

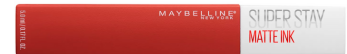
Students need to wear black sneakers or black hip hop shoes.

Makeup

All students need to wear makeup. Please remember that stage lights will wash out facial features if you are wearing little or no makeup. Therefore, makeup needs to be applied heavily for performance! Below are some tips:

GIRLS

- **Base** - (a little darker than their normal color)
- **Powder** - (to help with shine)
- **Eye Makeup** - **NO BLUES OR PURPLE, Browns, and Golds are the best.** Contour the crease of the eye with a darker color than the lid. Use cream or white on the top of the lid to the eyebrow. Then blend the lid, crease, and top of the lid together. Outline the lid of the eye with black eyeliner (thin) and halfway under the eye (thin).
- **Mascara** - Black
- **Lipstick** - Stay All Day lipstick to prevent smearing. Reds and/or deep roses. Example: Maybelline Super Stay Matte Ink Color - Dancer
- **Blush** - Rose colors. Place high on the cheeks.



BOYS

- **Powder** - minimal for the boys. This is just to help with the shine.
- **Eye Makeup** - Outline the lid of the eye with brown or black eyeliner (thin) and halfway under the eye (thin)
- **Lip Gloss** - Clear

REMEMBER, THE STAGE LIGHTS WILL WASH OUT FACIAL FEATURES IF YOU ARE WEARING LITTLE OR NO MAKEUP

LOWER ORCHESTRA SEATS - These tickets will be on sale for \$25 as they have in years past. Tickets may be purchased at the Theater or Arena downtown with no extra fees or via Ticketmaster which may have additional fees. These tickets are scheduled to go on sale on May 1st.

UPPER ORCHESTRA SEATS- These tickets will be on sale for \$20. Tickets may be purchased at the Theater or Arena downtown with no extra fees or via Ticketmaster which may have additional fees. These tickets are scheduled to go on sale on May 1st.

BALCONY - The first 4 rows of the balcony will be on sale for \$25 beginning May 1st. This remaining seats in the balcony will be open seating (seats not assigned). Tickets for this area are at no cost and may be picked up at the studio beginning June 2 contingent upon NancyDance Studio receiving June's tuition payment and any outstanding past due balances. Tickets will not be given to anyone having outstanding balances.

No videos or cameras are allowed in the theater during the recital!
No videos/pictures will be allowed to be taken during the performance. This is for the safety of the dancers and to be courteous to all audience members.

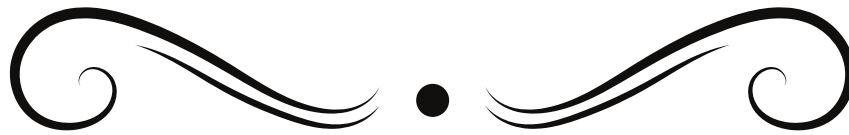

No one is allowed backstage once the show begins.

THINGS TO REMEMBER FOR RECITAL DAY

- **NO Costumes in Audience**

No students dressed in costumes will be permitted in the "audience." Please be sure to bring a change of clothes for your child and don't forget underpants! Mothers or female helpers wearing backstage passes are requested to come backstage after their child's last performance and take them back into the audience **after** they have changed out of their costumes during Act II only. **Students cannot be picked up during the Ballet.** If your child is only in Ballet, you will need to wait until intermission to pick up your child. Thank you for your cooperation.

- **NO Underpants**

Girls are not to wear underpants with their costumes/tights. Panties can be seen on stage when the lights shine on them. It helps to explain to the younger girls that tights are like wearing underpants. Young boys should wear snug boxer briefs. Older boys need to wear dance belts.

- **Backstage**

One parent with a backstage pass may escort their dance backstage to their designated area.

- **Arrival**

Dancers need to arrive backstage on Recital Night by 5:00 pm

*****IMPORTANT*****

Backstage Rules for Recital Day



- **Volunteer Opportunities**

We need 3 - 4 Moms for each class to sit with the students backstage.

We will be emailing out a link for a SignUp Genius in the next couple of weeks.

You will need to commit to volunteering for BOTH Dress Rehearsal and Recital days.

- Students are to arrive in full costume, makeup, and hair. One parent (remember to wear the backstage wristband) may escort the student through the backstage area to their designated area. There will be volunteers to assist you with escorting them to the proper area/group. There will also be "Recital Runners" in charge of backstage operations. **Should they ask you for assistance, please adhere!** All students need to be there by 5:00 pm on Recital Day.
- **Only Volunteer Moms, Recital Runners, and Teachers are allowed on the stage level.** Students will only be allowed on this level prior to going on stage for their performance. The rest of the time they need to be in their assigned area/group or in the dressing room.
- A parent (wearing their backstage wristband) will be allowed to come backstage during **intermission only or after your child's last dance in Act II** to change their child's costume or pick them up. Remember, students are not allowed to wear costumes in the audience, so be sure to change them to their personal attire.
- NO video cameras are allowed in the theatre during the recital! No videos/pictures will be allowed to be taken during the recital show. This is for the safety of your children and courteousness to all audience members. **However, picture/video taking will be allowed during dress rehearsal.**
- **Parents: Please talk to your child about obeying these rules. Stress to them the importance of being quiet and following directions at all times. They cannot talk while sitting in their seats or while waiting to enter the stage. If parents set a good example, the children will follow. Remember...the fewer people backstage, the more successful the show!**
